

Baseline Expectations for Students Who Are Quarantined

From time to time, students will be quarantined for at least 14 days due to being a close contact with a positive COVID-19 case. To ensure learning continues to take place as best as possible during the quarantine period, the following baseline expectations should serve as a guide when students are isolated or quarantined due to COVID.

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1. Students that have been granted permission to Zoom through the nurse's office will have access to zoom with her/her classroom the next school day. Teachers are not required to allow student access on the day of COVID report or student being sent home from school due to exposure, being positive, or showing COVID symptoms.
2. If student is calling off absent from school due to illness other than COVID, the student is to rest and recover. Zoom access is not granted to these students as it is imperative that they rest so he/she can return to school as soon as possible. Students can access recorded versions of classroom instruction following their normal class period.
3. Schoology assignments can be accessed and completed at any time during their time at home; however, assignments must be submitted in a timely manner in accordance to the Student Handbook.
4. Students are instructed to reach out to their teacher with questions or concerns.
5. Teachers are not required to provide 10 or 14 days of instructional material at one time. Teachers may provide instructional materials for two to three days at a time if he/she wishes to do so. All instructional material can be located in Schoology. Students are aware of how he/she is able to access the teacher's material. If questions, students are instructed to reach out to their teacher.
